IMPORTANT Resolution

Going before Port Stephens Council this Tuesday 12th December 2023- i.e. Requesting Council to:

- 1. Take a strategic leadership role by demonstrating to the NSW Government its interest in the future of the Tomaree Lodge
- 2. Explore operational options and future management options that do not negatively affect Council's finances, with the community, the Tomaree Headland Heritage Group and any other interested groups
- 3. Commits to playing a role in planning the future of the Tomaree Lodge site being led by the NSW Government, including taking the necessary steps to formally establish a Master Plan
- 4. Acknowledges that currently up to \$1M is being spent on security and maintenance of the site and request that the NSW Government commits some of this funding be put forward for future planning
